

*PROVINCE VI  
STANDING RULES*

1. A gift is presented to each retiring Province Governor and is to be purchased by the Chairman of the Board of Governors. Said gift not to exceed fifty dollars (\$50).
2. Only the Hostess Chapter may hold a raffle at the annual Province meeting. Tickets are to be sold to Sigma Beta members exclusively.
3. The province guest book will be kept by the Province Governor and she will bring it to each province meeting. (amended 1997)
4. A written copy of all reports submitted at a Province meeting is to be given to the Secretary at the end of the report. (Amended 1997 in accordance with by-law change Article II, section 1.)
5. In case of death in the "Immediate Family" of a member of the Province, any remembrance given shall be left to the discretion of the Executive Board. (Immediate family includes mother, father, spouse, and children of members.)
6. In case of serious illness\* or hospital confinement of any Executive Board member a gift shall be sent. (\*Serious illness to be determined by the Executive Board.)
7. A Province Sigma Beta of the Year will be chosen from letters submitted by the chapters. One outside judge will make the selection. The Province Treasurer (as amended in accordance with by-law change, Article II, section 1. - 1997) will purchase the Sigma Beta of the Year pin and also six (6) yellow roses. The banner and crown will be passed on every year. The registration to Province of the current Sigma Beta of the Year will be paid for by the Province. (amended 1995)
8. Province VI to make a \$25 donation to the Memorial Fund for the outgoing National President. (Amended 1991)
9. Luncheon expense for the Chairman of the Board of Governors at the annual Province meeting shall be paid from the treasury.
10. An invitation to the annual Province meeting shall be extended to all National Officers and Province Governors. (Amended 1990)
11. Province meetings shall be hosted on a rotating basis. (Amended 1989)
12. Each chapter to be assessed fifty dollars (\$50) each year to be presented at the annual Province meeting. Monies go into the Province treasury. (Amended

1998)

13. Founder's Day celebration shall be the last Sunday in January. Plans and type of celebration will be made by each chapter in the Province on a rotating basis. (Amended 2005)
14. The annual Province money making project monies shall be designated as Charity funds. (Added 1987)
15. Province VI annual charity shall be the scholarship recipient. If we have no scholarship recipient in any year, the decision will be voted on by the recommendation of the Charity Committee.
16. Any National officer in attendance of the Province VI meeting will have their registration fee(s) paid by the Province treasury. (Added 1991)
17. Each chapter will be assessed twenty-five (\$25) per quarter. (added 1997)
18. All by-laws, amendments, and standing rule changes for additions, histories, and Province minutes will be mailed to each chapter president and province officers within sixty (60) days after the annual Province meeting. (April 1999)
19. Chapters that have been excused from Province obligations by the National Executive Board are excused from financial obligations to the Province. (Created 2007)
